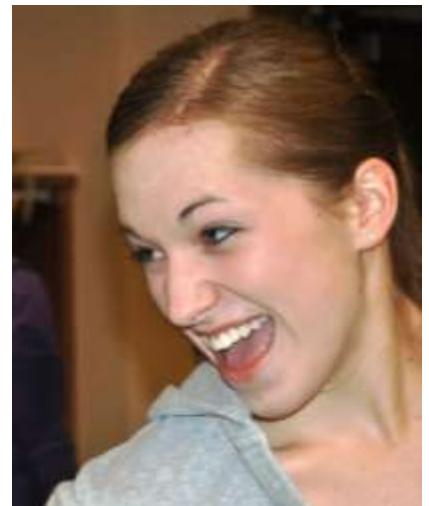

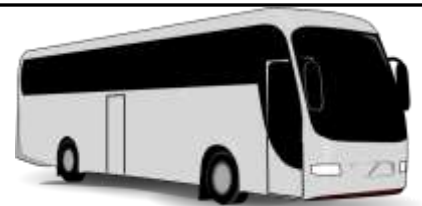
Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT)
